**Sand Dollar Cards** – Drop to \$5 to move out the leftovers. \$1330 profit made on the cards

**Change for Maclary** – Kathy Banks – Feb. 12-28 buckets go home with kids. Collection will be Feb. 28-March 2. Kids get a ruler for participating. Commerce Bank counts the change for free. Volunteers are needed for the three days of collection.

**Reflections** – Caryn Duca – Reception will be this Friday. 170 entries. 120 RSVPs so far for the awards banquet. Need to move display boards down from the stage.

**Yearbook** – Brooke Kelly- Forms went out. Will need a person to take over next year, since Brooke and Michelle will not be here next year. Possibly looking into having 5<sup>th</sup> graders help with the yearbook as well.

**Teacher Appreciation** – Brooke and Tina – Looking into doing a soup and salad luncheon. Getting prices together.

**Bulldog Valentines** – Tina Mah – placed order for 250 carnations with Kirk's Flowers. They are selling them to us at cost, 40 cents each. Printing cost were \$35 for flyers and Valentine Cards. Jeannie requested we buy some extra to put in the Teacher's Lounge in a vase, bump order up to 300. Will need a group of volunteers to help assemble the bouquets and deliver them.

**Shamrock Hop** – Tina Mah – set for March 9. Need to pre-sell admission tickets because the event always sells out. There is a max. allowable number of people posted in cafeteria. They went over that last year. Recommended to sell tickets for food, drinks and glow sticks so cash is only handled in one area.
